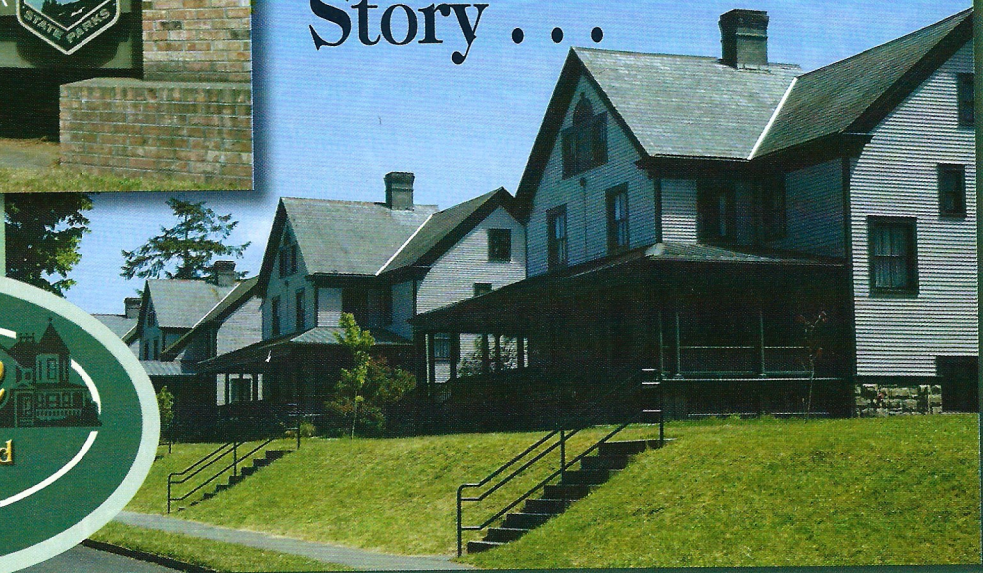




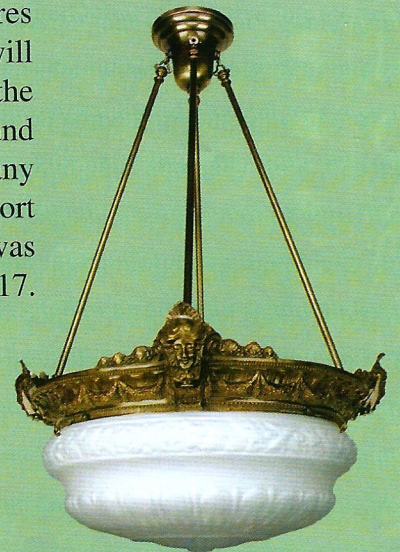
# The Fort Worden Story . . .



Restoration of the Officers' Quarters at Fort Worden State Park Conference Center required not only period lighting fixtures appropriate to the early 1900's, it required that the fixtures accepted low wattage, energy efficient, compact fluorescent lamps.

Vintage Hardware & Lighting not only met the challenge of adapting several period lighting fixtures to accept fluorescent lamps, but went one step further to incorporate the latest, state-of-the-art "Electronic Chip CF" technology into the Fort Worden project. These "ECF" lamps offer many superior features over the older "curly" fluorescent and incandescent bulbs. Six times more energy efficient than incandescent lamps and a wider selection of color temperature hues are just two of the advantages of "ECF" lamps ~ and ~ the ballast and bulbs are Energy Star 4 approved.

When visiting the Officers' Quarters, take time to look at the lighting fixtures in the various rooms. What you will see are masterful reproductions of the lighting that originally graced the walls and ceilings of these historic structures. Many were custom crafted especially for Fort Worden. Construction on the fort was started in 1898 and completed in 1917.
