





Optional Key: All of our cabinet locks S-1 thru S-9, except S-7, are supplied with the fancy key bow as shown in the pictures. However, if you wish the lock to come with this more simple "Optional Key" there will be a change in the stock number to be ordered. This

key is denoted as the "G" key. Therefore, as an example, if you wanted to order the S-1 type lock with the "G" type key, you just add "G" to the stock number ie" S-1G or for the S-2 order S-2G etc. S-7, S-A6B, S-A6S, S-A11L and S-A11R, are supplied only with the "G" key.



SOLID BRASS KEYS: Blank and Skeleton


<u>S-KB</u> Key blank. Meas 2 1/4" long overall with 1" long shaft. Pin hole 1/8"

S-KS Skeleton key made from S-KB

S-GB Key blank Meas 2 11/16" long w/-1 1/2" long shaft. Pin hole 1/8"

S-GS Skeleton key made from S-GB. Both skeleton keys have the same key pattern and fit approximately 80% of old and antique locks but we cannot be responsible for them breaking in old rusted or jammed locks.

Use the bottom illustration for determining the measurements of our locks. Remember that it is possible to use a slightly larger mortised lock by removing a little more wood from your drawer or door.



Locks for special applications---note the illustration and then the chart below for sizes of these locks.

<u>S-A3L</u> and <u>S-A3R</u> are American Style antique locks. They will fit several existing situations and will fit in the space of smaller locks by removing a little more wood. These are available in both left (L) and right (R) hand and can be used on both drawers and doors.

<u>S-A6B</u> (brass) and <u>S-A6S</u> (steel) are American style deep drawer locks. The only difference is the base metal construction. Come only with the S-GB style key. The size of brass lock and the steel lock are identical.

S-A11L (left) and **S-A11R** (right) Rare "wardrobe door" locks. Can be used on any door where simple closing as well as locking are desired.

Available in both left and right models. These locks are supplied only with the S-GB style keys and the lock catch plate is supplied as shown. We suggest using either D-8A and D-11A for cupboard turns that will work with these locks.

Distance from the center of the round part of the keyhole to the center of the square turn bit is 1 1/8" .The lock bolt and passage bolt both have a throw of 1/4". The "Catch Plate", which is reversible, can be used for either left or right hand locks. It can be ordered by itself using the stock number S-A11X. S-A11X catch plate measures: 3 3/8" x 1/2" less tongue.

All solid Brass half-mortised locks with solid brass keys--various sizes

<u>S-3, S-4, S-5, S-6</u> All half mortised door or drawer locks. Every part of each lock is brass even the rivets and pins. We make the right hand lock only as shown in the above picture. It is possible to use these locks upside down for a left hand door which means that the key would be inserted upside down. Check the chart below for the sizes of each lock.

<u>S-7, S-8, S-9</u> All half mortised brass box and chest locks. The two small locks (S-8 & S-9) are used for lap desks, tea caddies, game boxes, small tool boxes etc.

The large S-7 chest lock is used for cedar or any large blanket or tool chests or similar applications.

See the chart for sizes. Comes with locking plates as shown. Optional key available for S-8 and S-9. See picture marked "Optional Key" for a full explanation of stock numbers. S-7 uses only the S-GB key. bow.

<u>S-1 And S-2</u> These two surface locks are the easiest of all locks to use. They simply fit up flush to the inside of a door or drawer even where no lock has been before.

All that must be done is to drill a hole for the key. the bolt for these locks travels both right and left; therefore they can be used on either left or right hand doors and all drawers. Consult chart for sizes.

<u>S-10</u> Composition "brass plated" barrel cylinder lock. Supplied with two keys and the surface mounted decor barrel ring. Barrel 13/16" dia (21mm).

EXTRA KEYS: can be ordered for any lock. Best to look at the price list for understanding, but briefly, the fancy key is ordered by the lock stock number, of the lock key you want, plus the addition of the letter "K". An extra key for S-1 would be ordered as S-1K etc.

If the extra key you desire is the "G" key the stock number for an S-1 extra key would be S-G1K. A glance at the price for the key listings should help settle any confusion.

Lengths of keys as follows:

Fancy key: overall length 2 1/4" and the shaft into the lock measures: 1" long; Pin hole 1/8".

Optional "G" key overall length of 2 11/16"; shaft length into the lock 1 1/2"; pin hole of 1/8".
