

**ZLW-88SDL** Great old Victorian screen door lock re-created by Lost Wax casting.

Lock Body: 2 1/8"wide by 3 1/2"long Catch: 2"wide by 7/8"inside leg. The latch has an especially long tongue. It is best to inset this latch, past the edge of the door about an 1/8" or so, in order

that the rounded part of the tongue engages the catch. We are guessing that it was designed to accomodate larger gaps between the screen door and jam. This is a locking screen door latch.



## Fine Victorian Screen Door Latch Set: ZLW-107SDL

Of course, if you just HAD to have a bigger knob for the outside door, or wanted a lever for one side, you could still get this set and use the knobs that come with it on furniture while you replace them with larger different patterned ones. **Lock:** 2 1/4"wide x 1 7/8"long. Latch is locking type with catch: 2"wide by 7/8"inside leg. **Knob** is 1 1/4"dia & 1"tall. **Backplate:** 1"wide by 2 1/8" tall. Set Consists of:



**ZLW-110** The best recreated, Victorian decorated, door rim lock in America. This super rim lock was made by Mallory, Wheeler and was patented 1873. We have reproduced it right down to the patent date (visible in the picture) and the Mallory Wheeler signature on the other side. Every part of this lock is either precision cast or heavy wrought. This lock had to be done to perfection...and is. The lock is fully reversible so that one lock is for all doors. In addition to having a passage turn latch with star broach, it also has a locking key bolt that works from either side of the door. In addition to the key bolt, there is a manual privacy bolt operable from only inside the room and independant of the key.

Case: 4 3/4"tall; 3 5/8"wide; 13/16"thick

Catch: 4 3/4"tall; 13/16"wide; One Key: 3 3/4"long **ZLW-162F** Very finely lost wax cast re-creation of a bed room or bath passage rim lock also by Mallory, Wheeler Circa 1870. No key, just a slide bolt from the inside of the room. Case: 2 1/2"wide by 3 1/2"long; Catch: 2 1/2"wide by7/8"deep. The lost wax cast detail is marvelous.

These two locks are presented in Mallory'Wheeler's catalog of 1882. They boast there that they were awarded "Gold Metals" at the Paris Exposition of 1878 for "reversible locks" of which, naturally, these two locks were submitted.
