In rare cases, larger keyholes will be required, in our backplates, to fit some lock keys. This will require the slight filing of slightly larger keyholes. We make our backplates exactly as found. It is the installer's responsibility to file larger keyholes.



ZE-522 Larger backplate by R&E. Pat Jan 25, 1870. Shown in 1870 catalog w/-ZE-26 doggie knob nice with all. 8 1/2" x 2 5/8" wide Center of knob to center of the 1st keyhole round bit: 2 1/4" & to the 2nd keyhole: 4" It can use our lock L-9 (1st keyhole) or a combination of L-6 and L-74 for the 2nd keyhole.





ZE-100 Two Bird's doorknob by R&E; 1879 Ours is molded directly from the antique. Pat 11,226 by R. Christensen in the (Aesthetic) Japanese style. 2 1/8" diameter and projects 2". Fine. ZE-100 is an arbitrary number since no catalog survives to show it, but we have the patents to prove it's origin.



ZLW-198L Recreation of a Victorian thumb latch-lock. Case: 2 3/4" by 3"; face: 1 1/8w by 4 5/8"t; 2"to the center of the backset. Great!

ZE-700 The only thumb latch shown in the 1870 R&E catalog. 9 1/4" long x 2 1/8"w Use lock ZLW-198L Very rare reproduction. ZE-550 Larger back plate by R&E. Pat. Jan 25, 1870. Shown in 1870 catalog w/-ZE-38 knob but nice with all. 8" tall x 2 5/8" wide. Center of knob to center of the keyhole round bit: 2 3/4". Use antique lock or our L-101 lock.





ZE-971 Flying Bird doorknob by R&E; 1879 Ours is molded directly from an original. Pat 11,227 by R. Christensen in the (Aesthetic) Japanese style. 2 1/4" diameter and projects 2". Lovely and rare



ZE-546 Smaller backplate by R&E. Pat. Jan 25, 1870. 6 3/4" tall x 2 1/4" wide. Center of knob to center of the keyhole round bit: 2 1/2". Use antique lock or our L-102 lock created for this backplate and ZA-811..great !!



ZE-25 Lion doorknob by MCCC/R&E.
Popular opinion, amongst collectors, is that this large lion knob is more rare and more collectable than the Doggy Doorknob. It was amongst the first four original patents by Kreuzinger. (Pat: 4097) Ours is taken directly from the original. A great large knob: 2 7/8" diameter and projects 3". Nice deep relief.

ZE-561 Tall & narrow backplate by R&E. Catalog VII dated:1887 9 1/2" x 2" Center of knob to center of the 1st keyhole round bit: 2 1/4" & to the 2nd keyhole: 4" It can use our lock L-9 (1st keyhole) or a combination L-6 & L-74 for the 2nd keyhole. Often shown with ZE-926/936
