<u>113-MJX-EP</u> & <u>117-GJX-EP</u>

The only difference between these two lovely pendents, is the size of the shade. While 113 light uses a 17 1/2"square shade, 117 light uses the much larger 21 3/4" square shade. This is the same shade that is sold on our two floor lamps. The stems, of both lights, are the same and each has four sockets...each one rated for 100 watts. 113 is 36" long with shade. Can be shortened to as little as 17". 117 is 38"long with shade. Can shorten to as little as 19".

For every metal shade on this page, small, medium and large, we offer the option of choosing the color of art glass desired. Art glass choices are found on the shade pages.

R. Williamson of Chicago has been an inspriation for many of our mission and Victorian lamps. This very unusual hall light is no exception. The antique is Circa 1890 and originally burned gas but was later converted to electricity. Our re-creation's socket is rated for more than 100 watts, so you can surely get plenty of light in your hall or small room. Height: 36"; shortest 26"; width: 15 1/2" fitter: 4'


102-DPL-SE Double light. Two brass fitters for 2 1/4" glass shades each rated for 100 watts each. Has base switch and a polarized plug. 21 1/2" tall; Base is 6"sq; width from shade edge to shade edge is 18". Wonderful for a library table; student desk.

Suggested shades: 080G, 065G or 083G or 093G




With four hundred watts of light, our girl Raechel has more than enough light for her Gameboy. A nice quiet setting to concentrate on a high score. And our fine Mission floor light is just the ambience for a living room, play room or den. Four brass, pull chain, sockets rated for 100 watts each with a nice large shade (available in three art glass colors). Shade is 21 3/4" square and the height of the light is just shy of 66" to the top of the finial. Base measures just under 14"square and contains a heavy cast iron load to maintain stability. Supplied in Darkened antique finish-a nice light indeed. Three colors of art glass









Five light Mission large pan chandelier. Large lovely shaped pan measures just under 14"square. Each socket is rated for a 100 watt bulb which equals 500 watts total. Note the lovely Lost Wax cast center decor and the side panels. All absolutely authentic in every detail.

This five light also is available with art glass metal shades in both the diamond and chain patterns originally made by Sechrist of Denver, Circa 1900. Overall height without shades: 28" (an average of 32"-33" with shades) but can be shortened by removing chain links.
