





P&F Corbin, Circa 1900, Italian Renaissance **School** ZLW-188K (roaring lion doorknob)

and a ZLW-189 & ZLW-189KO

Very nice backplates and knob which are shown in the Circa 1900 catalogs of P&F Corbin.

Corbin called this pattern "Pavia Design". The lion oval knob meas: 2"wide by 2 7/8"long and 2 3/8"tall. Comes with connecting spindle.

The backplates ZLW-189 and ZLW-189KO meas: wide by 18" tall and have a design of surmounted double full figured cherubs flanking a lion's head. Very classical and for that matter...very ancient Roman. Both knob and backplates

hi/lo finish. This set is a late addition to the catalog. Other configurations of this backplate will follow.



an twist doorbell operator. Made by Sargent Circa 1900, they put this turn knob on about everything since it was so pleasing. Backplate: 1 1/4" wide by 3 1/8"

Wrought Rim Locks

Locks are fully reversible by simply turning them over. Note the figure 8 keyhole for this purpose Steel case-painted flat black

without door knob receiver. Steel case thickness: .0373 L-130 Solid Brass - polished with standard 11/16' doorknob receiver. Brass case thickness: .054"

Both locks, outside measurements: Lock case: 4 3/16" wide by 6"long Catch: 4 3/16" wide by 1 11/16"

Backsets: to center of knob bit is 4 3/8" to the center of the k/hole is 1 11/16" These locks are interior door quality and are not high security devices
