







538-D.JX-ES Double "Mission" wall Sconce | shade. This is the same shade that is sold on Width: 15.25", Projects: 9" Tall:10" | our two floor lamps. The stems, of both lights, are the same and each has four sockets...each one rated for 100 watts. 112 is 36" long with shade. Can be shortened to as little as 17" 116 is 38"long with shade. Can be shortened to as little as 19".

Three nice table lights

The diamond and chain motif brass shades from Circa 1910-20 are reproduced in pendants; chandeliers, table & floor lamps--all match.

105-MJX-PL Single light. diamond shade motif, table lamp. Choose the glass color of your choice on the shade page. Has base switch and a polarized plug. 21 1/2" tall; Base is 6"sq; from back of the base to tip of the shade: 13" projection. Very nice gentle light.


106-DJX-PL Double light. Brass diamond shade motif, table lamp. Choose the glass color of your choice on the shade page. Has base switch and a polarized plug. 21 1/2" tall; Base is 6"sq; width from shade edge to shade edge is 18". Wonderful for a library table.

111-BJX-PL Large Brass chain shade motif, table lamp. Choose the glass color of your choice on the shade page. Has two pull chain sockets inside the shade (rated 100 watts each) and a polarized plug. 27 1/2" tall; Base is 6 3/4"square; Actual shade is 17 1/2" on all sides (8" tall by itself).

All the sockets we use are rated for 100 watts and above. When we recommend a rating of 60-75 watts, it is not because the lamp socket cannot handle it...it is to protect the valuable art glass we use in our shades. Bulbs in the early 1900's did not produce the light, nor heat, of modern bulbs.







The rectangular pans used in the 425 series lights are 7" x 14" x 1" Lights in this series are mounted to the ceiling with the center finial.

425-SPN-CX or 425-SPN-JX Height: 36", Spread: 15", We recommend 60-75 watt for these art glass and metal shades.

425-SPN-EP Ht: 36.5", Spread: 14", Fitter for glass shade: 2 1/4" Glass shades accept 100 watt bulbs. Suggested shades are 080G, 065G or 083G or 093G

522-QCC-JX Great close ceiling 'Mission' light having four shades. Please note the "rare" reproducedshape of this pan fixture. Complete with authentic side decorations and

mounting center finial and decor. More outstanding, and harder to reproduce, than anything on the market. This fixture, with shades, is only 13 1/2"tall. Nicely Darkened. Each socket is rated for 100 watts, but we recommend 60-75 watts to protect the art glass. We are mixing items on this page to give you an idea how to mix and match lighting
