505-MSW-ES

505 and 507 are Edwardian period, swivel reading lights. They were originally made by Horn & Brannon, Circa 1900. Both are supplied with a canopy switch. Backplates are 5" in dia. Sockets are rated for a 100 watt bulb. Shades sold separately.

505-MSW-ES is a single swivel light extending out to 14"
507-DSW-ES is a double swivel light that can extend to 26.5" using both swing arms. Both are good lighting for over a desk

753-PTL-CH



753-PTL-CH Nice large span light. Normally used for a billiard table, but equally at home across a kitchen counter giving powerful downward light. The decorative scrolls can be adjusted downwards and along the arms, giving many different looks to this light. This nice light spans 60" wide; and has an initial height of 46". It can be shortened to 34" by cutting the stem and moving the scrolls down the center pipe and along the arms. The fitters are 3 1/4" and while they work best with our green cone shade (092G), we can also supply a white shade and 4" fitters if so desired. The original antique fixture that this was re-created from, has been attributed to Pettigrew-Andrews out of Boston, Circa 1900. The shade holders have a pleasant old world favor while the brass sockets are rated for 150 watts each. Powerful lighting.

In Victorian times, wall sconces were called "Bracket Lights" or simply "Brackets". Companies such as H.J. Peters of Chicago, & Gibson Gas of Phila. and many others, made nearly identical "Brackets" making only minor changes. Here are some that were very popular then:

604-DAE-ES Height: 8", Canopy: 5", Width: 22.5", Fitters: 2 1/4" electric
703-ES Height: 10 1/2" w/shade, Dia. Canopy 4 3/4", Width: 5 1/4", Projects: 9", Shade fitter: 2.25"

703-GAS Height: 10" w/shade, Dia Canopy 4 3/4", Width: 7 1/2", Projects: 10", Fitters are 4" up style gas type

703-MGE Height: 13.5" w/shades, Dia Canopy: 4.75", Width: 7.5", Projects: 10", Shade fitters: One 4" gas and one 2.25" electric

704-ES Height: 10.5", W: 8.25", P: 14", F: 2.25"
704-GAS Height: 10 1/2", Width: 10 3/4", Projects: 17", Fitters: 4" up gas

Note that all electric shades on this page are held by a lovely shaped fitter called a "Hubbel" fitter. "Hubbel" electric fitters are 2 1/4" size. Gas shades are held by a nicely pierced 4" gas fitter.

Two Nice Arts and Crafts Lights

3375-P (Table Lamp) Arts & Crafts table light with Mica paneled shade. Meas: 23 1/2" tall by 14" wide; two pull chain sockets rated for 100 watts each. This light can be used very nicely with oak mission furniture as the lines remind you of the furniture of those times.

This nice table light matches the floor lamp 3375-PFL.

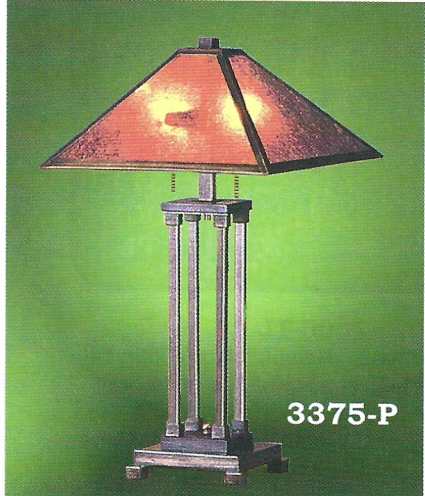
3375-PFL (floor lamp)

Arts & Crafts floor lamp with Mica paneled shade. Meas: 62" tall by 16" wide; two pull chain sockets rated for 100 watts each. This light could be used very nicely with oak mission furniture as the lines remind you of mission furniture.
