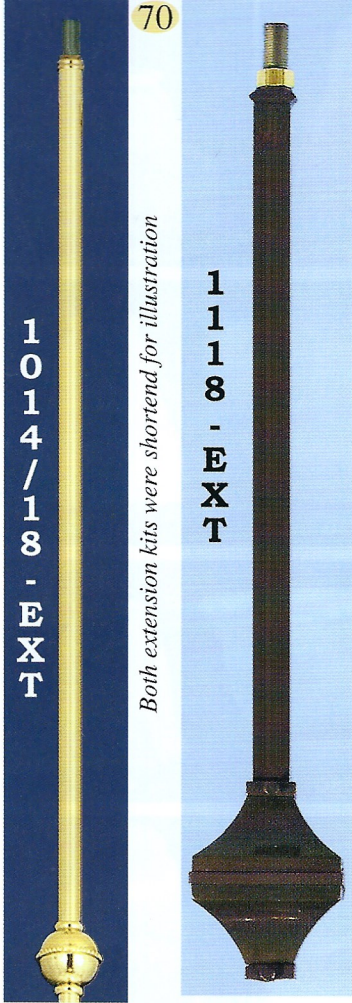

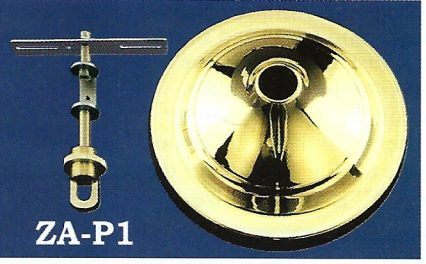

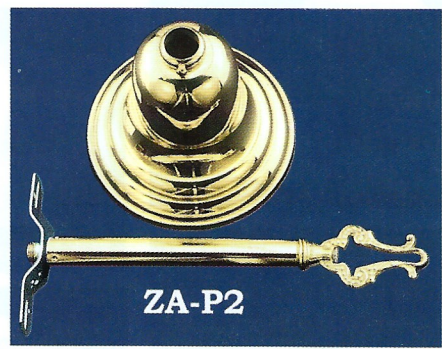
For Victorian Chandeliers that have a 3/4" round brass tube.

1118-EXT For Mission fixtures that use square 3/4" tube.

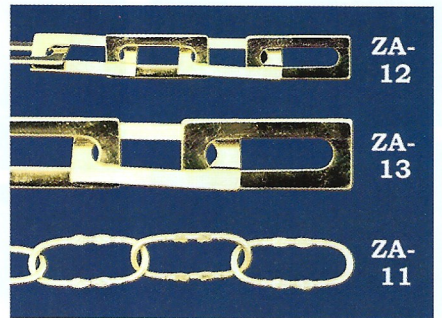
Both extension kits for Chandeliers, fit either 1/4 IPS or 1/8 IPS all-threads as we supply both adapters. AND they can add 65" to your light, but less, if you trim the kit.

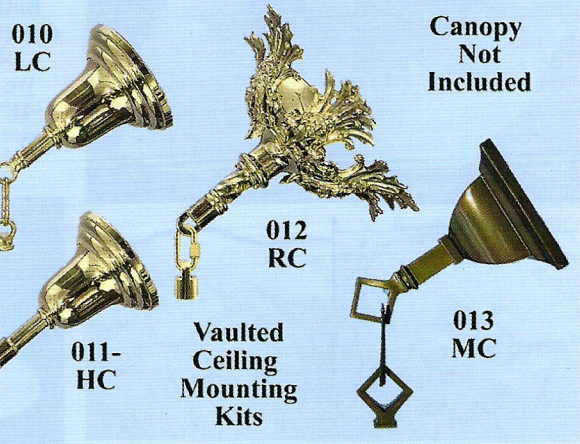

Two canopy kits **ZA-P1** (6" dia) and **ZA-P2** (5" dia) for old chandeliers that might be missing canopy mount kits. Four types of chains

to help you extend the length of chain chandeliers : **ZA-11** **ZA-12** **ZA-13** All chain is sold by the linear foot.

All fitters below are supplied with set screws as shown

- ZV-2** Solid Brass 2 1/4" fitter
- ZV-3** Solid Brass 3 1/4" fitter
- ZV-4** Solid Brass 4" fitter
- ZV-5** Rare early Victorian Crown and Spoke 4" fitter. Very delicate recreation. Comes with ball set screws.
- ZV-6** Rare early Victorian Crown and Spoke 5" fitter. 5" fitters were used for a short time with gas chandeliers. Delicate recreation. Comes with ball set screws.
- ZV-7** 1900's style brass bell fitter for 2 1/4" shades. Slips 1/8 IPS thread; 2 5/8" tall
- ZV-8** Rare early Victorian lovely pierced 4" fitter. Lovely re-creation. Comes with ball set screws.
- ZV-9** Mission style brass

Vaulted Ceiling Mounting Kits

Canopies **ARE NOT** included. These kits are bought as an accessory to our lights when installing lighting on a vaulted ceiling. The canopy that came with the light is used.

ZV-11 Very rare re-creation of an early C.1840 gasolier fitter. Gas fixtures of this time used an unusual 2 5/8" size fitter. They also used different set screws. In fact, they used two bent prongs and one screw to hold the shade on. We changed this since original gas shades of this era can now cost 50 to 200 dollars each. We make our fitter with three screws for a more gentle mounting. Made by lost wax casting, it is authentic in every way. The center hole slips 1/8 IPS lamp thread. Rare fitter screws have been re-created and are supplied. A simple design to match any rococo light.



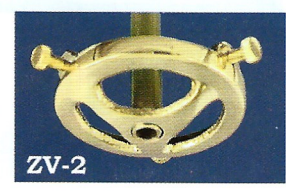

ZV-1 Brass plated, Clamp on fitter. Clamps onto a metal socket (not porcelain) and then you can add a shade with a 2 1/4" fitter. A very common use is for bridge lamps, but also used on any fixture without a fitter but with a metal socket.

bell fitter for 2 1/4" shades. Slips 1/8 IPS thread; 2 1/2" tall
ZV-10 Rare hubbel style brass bell fitter for 2 1/4" shades. Slips 1/8 IPS thread; 2 5/8" tall; and supplied with nice ball set screws. This rare fitter is made by a skilled hand "spinning" process using what is called a break-down die. This is the reason it is so rare today as hand spinning is becoming a lost art.



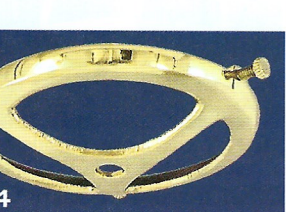

ZV-12 Turn of the Century style brass bell fitter for 4" shades. Slips 1/8 IPS thread; 2 3/4" tall

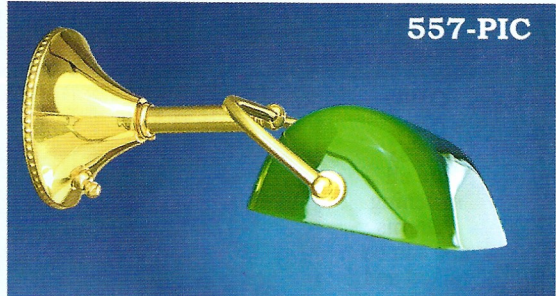
